

Residential Lock-Box Program

The Bainbridge Township Fire Department now has a Residential Lock-Box Program. This is a great resource for senior citizens, disabled residents, and those living alone with no one close by to help them in an emergency. Installation of the Lock-Box is free of charge for all residents.

A Residential Lock Box is a small, secured key box that is attached to a door and securely stores a house key for emergency situations. These lock boxes are only accessible by the Bainbridge Township Fire and Police Departments and will allow emergency personnel to access a residence in an emergency without damaging a door or window.

Cost for a Residential Lock Box is \$35 (payable to Bainbridge Township). When information and payment are received, a Fire Department representative will contact you to schedule an installation appointment. Please have a copy of your key available and ready at the time of the installation appointment.
