OLD BUSINESS

Columbariums

Mr. Seliga reported that he visited the cemeteries in Hudson, Ohio. They have two columbariums and presented photos of them to the board. The board discussed overall size, style, color, niche size, materials, roof style, cost to build, maintenance, fees and marketing. Mr. Seliga will contact Stroud Lawrence Funeral Home for information on a preferred niche size. The board was in agreement to continue to move forward by contacting local companies regarding styles and materials, researching costs and fees and having the scope of work and site plan completed.

Ohio Association of Cemetery Superintendents & Officials

Mr. Seliga reported that he checked with the Fiscal Officer's Office and no fee has been paid for the membership this year.

Military Marker Installation

Mr. Marous said that he had a request for a headstone that would be turned sideways and placed part in the walkway and part over the grave which is not permitted at Restland Cemetery. He contacted the monument company and the family will design a new plan.

Cemetery Management Software

The board discussed the cemetery software that the City of Hudson is using which is Legacy Mark and will look into that one as another possibility if PlotFinder is replaced.
